- 2. Do NOT bring your pets. Service animals are allowed but must wear a vest.
- β . NO smoking or open flames in the orchards.
- 4. NO ladders.
- 5. NO climbing the trees.
- 6. Do NOT break branches.
- 7. Do NOT litter. Trash receptacles can be found at the check-in tents.
- 8. Stay in designated area.
- 9. You are responsible for the safety and actions of your child.

Helpful Suggestion For A Good U-Pick Experience

Wear good shoes – sandals/flip flops not recommended.

Wear sunscreen & hat – temperatures are often near 100° and there is very little shade when not in the trees.

Strollers & wagons are allowed – very helpful when hauling kids + cherries.

Jogging strollers and wagons with bigger wheels are less likely to get stuck.

Plan enough time – it takes about 30 minutes for a single person to pick one 5.5 lbs bucket.
